

## **LISTON HALL RE-OPENING – Update August 7<sup>th</sup> 2020**

Marlow Community Association was delighted that we were able to reopen Liston Hall to a limited extent from Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July.

As an addition to our normal booking Conditions, we have prepared a set of conditions and guidelines relating to Covid-19 – these will be mandatory for all hirers and for every event, and will remain in force for the foreseeable future.

To enable us to adapt to government guidance as it develops, and taking into account advice from Community Impact Bucks at each stage, we have also produced a statement of the limitations that will apply from our reopening. This statement will be updated as the situation changes over the next few weeks and months and takes precedence over other conditions if contradictions occur.

From **August 8th** until further notice, following a change of guidance regarding face coverings, the following statement applies:

**All members of the public attending Liston Hall in any capacity must wear a face covering that safely covers the mouth and nose at all times.**

**We are not currently permitting any events that:**

- **may involve at any one time more than 30 people in the Main Hall, 10 people in the Garden Room or 10 people in the Thames Room**
- OR**
- **cannot ensure social distancing between households of at least 2 metres or 1 metre with additional measures such as face masks**
- OR**
- **involve physical exercise**

Bookings for events that do not comply with these conditions can be made for dates in the future, but hirers must bear in mind that these limitations and others may still be in force. If this is the case, your events will need to be modified or cancelled.

The Association reserves the right to refuse or cancel any booking that is or might be in contravention of the conditions & limitations stated.
