

## **LISTON HALL PERMITTED USE from 12 April 2021**

The following statement, based on current government regulations and guidance from Community Impact Bucks, applies until further notice:

### **Liston Hall reopens on Monday April 12<sup>th</sup> 2021 only for very limited activities**

**All supervised indoor children's activities are permitted, including dance classes, musical activities, cubs, scouts, brownies.**

**Parent and child groups are permitted, e.g. parent and toddlers, with up to 15 attending plus under-fives.**

**Sales are permitted in the Hall. Stalls/tables must be at least 2 metres apart and positioned around the wall, not in the middle of the hall. A maximum of 50 people at any one time is permitted to include all organisers and stall holders.**

**One-way systems for visitors must be enforced and distance maintained between stall holders and visitors. Face coverings, not just a visor, must be worn by everyone unless officially exempt.**

**For all types of event, at least 2 metres (1 metre if all involved are wearing face coverings) must be maintained between household groups. Maximum attendance at any event may therefore be limited.**

**Unless the individual has a valid official exemption, anyone visiting Liston Hall for any reason must wear a face covering which must be kept on at all times, except when participating in an exempt event type. The face covering must cover the nose and mouth; a visor alone is not sufficient.**

**Additional hygiene measures must be followed and ventilation maximised.**

**MCA's Covid-related booking conditions & guidelines are mandatory for all hirers and for every event and will continue to apply until at least mid-June. This is in addition to the normal Booking Conditions.**

**Your security deposit may be forfeit if any breaches of these or other conditions occur.**

Each booking will be assessed to ensure that it will be conducted in a way that complies with the law and current guidelines. The Association reserves the right to refuse any booking that is or might be in contravention of the conditions.

**Please note** - Liston Hall's cancellation penalties as stated in the normal Booking Conditions will be reintroduced from April 12th. If the rules change and MCA have to cancel paid-for bookings, refunds will be given.
